



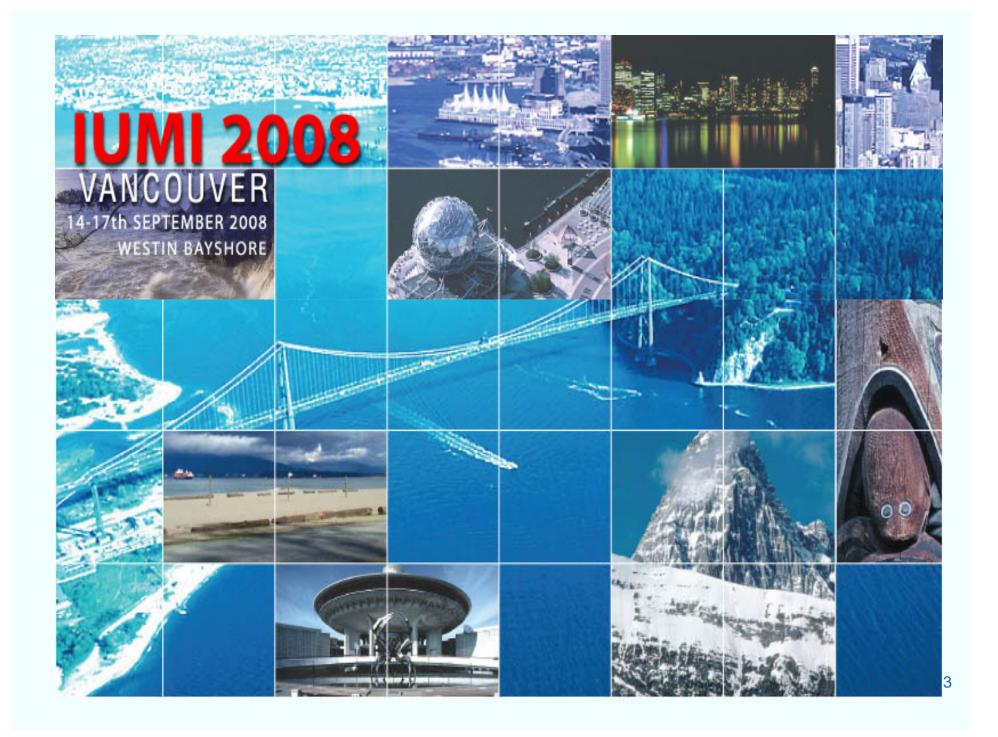

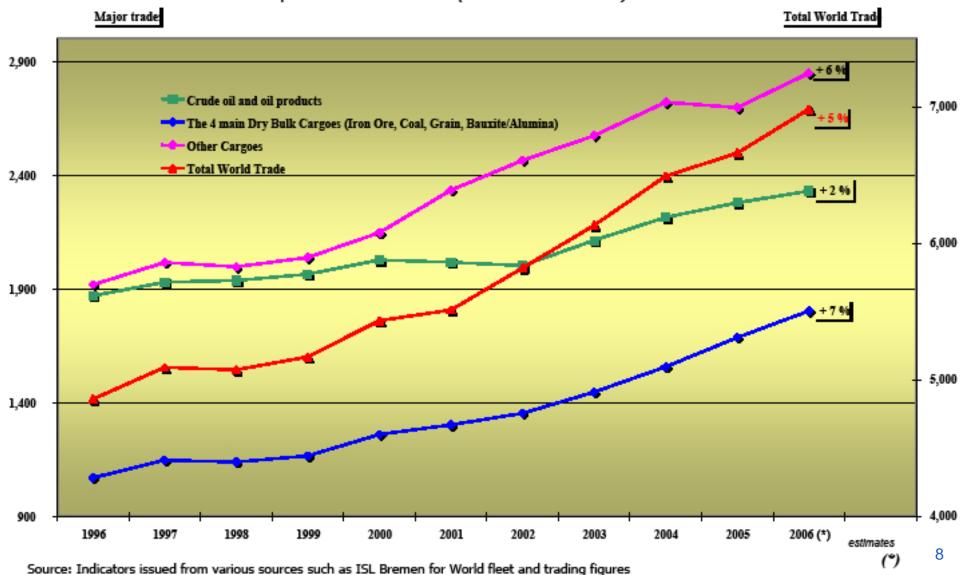

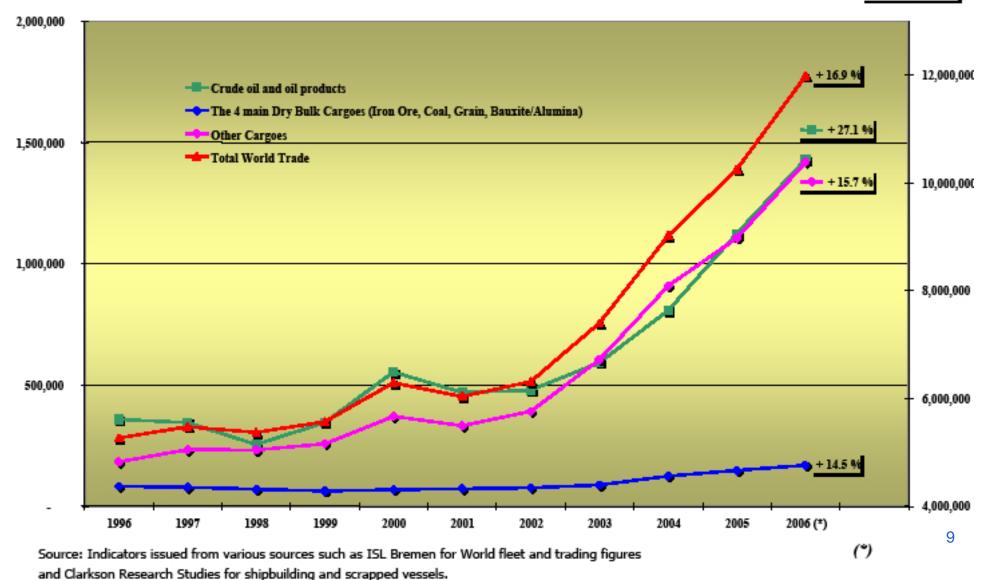


World Trade Values

Total World Trad & Other cargoes

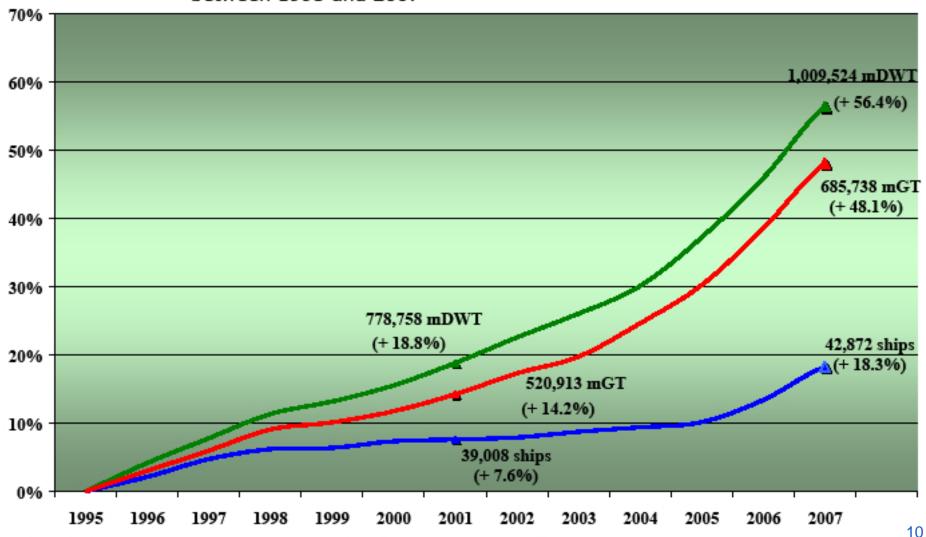

Evolution of the growth rates (GT, DWT, and Number of ships) between 1995 and 2007

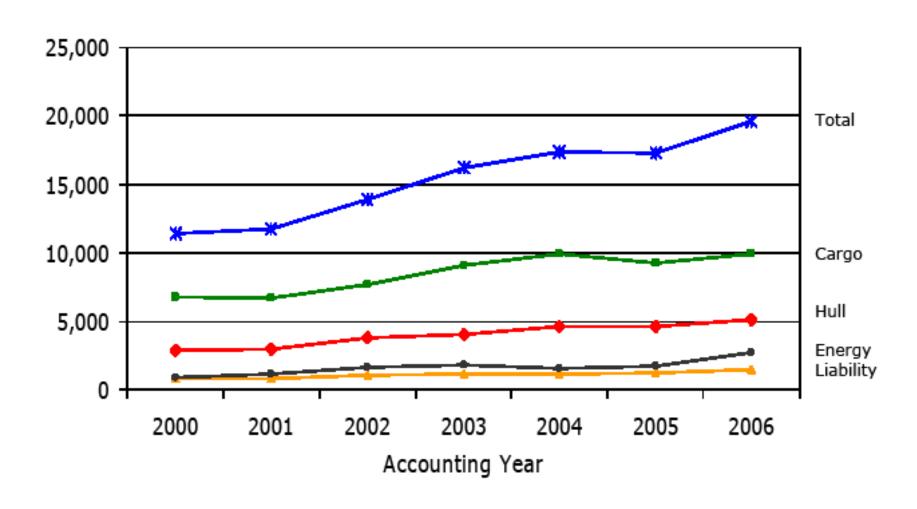


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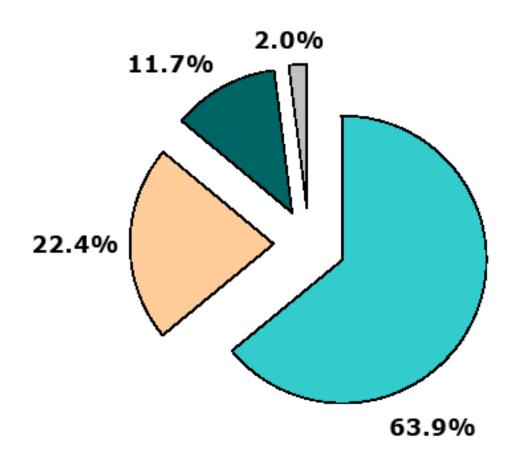
Global Marine Premium 2000 - 2006

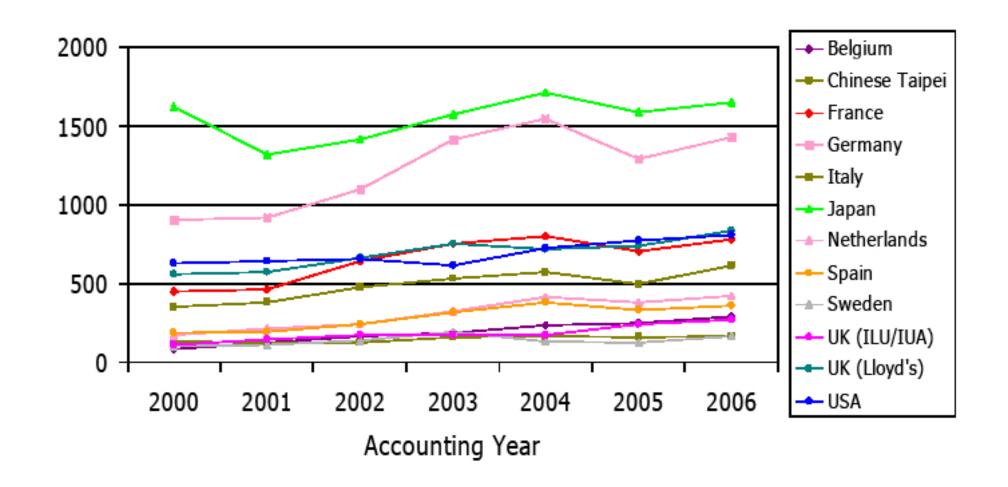

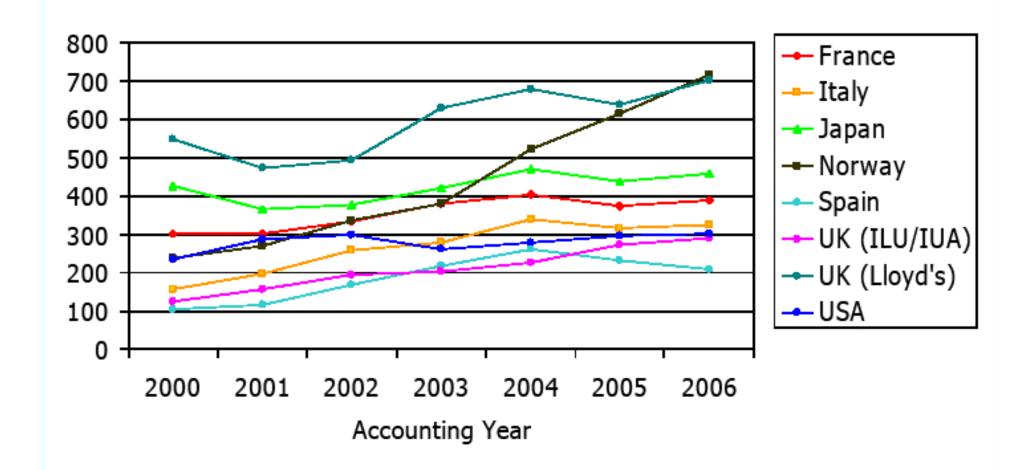


Global Cargo Premium Major Markets, 2000 - 2006 (USD Million)



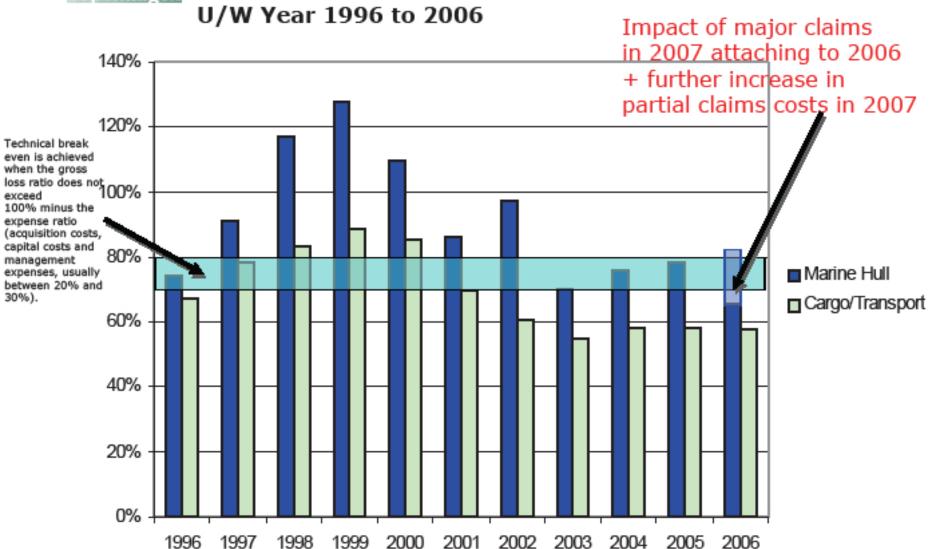


Global Hull Premium Major Markets, 2000 - 2006 (USD Million)
